INFORMATION ABOUT STUDENTS IN NEED OF SOCIAL PROTECTION STUDYING AT NAVOI STATE MINING AND TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY

In the 2021/2022 academic year, there are 86 (62 boys, 24 girls) students in need of social protection. Among them are 41 disabled people, 8 children of the "House of Mercy", 6 orphans, two from the "Youth Register" notebook, 6 from the "Iron Register" notebook, 4 from the "Women's Register" notebook and 19 poor and orphaned students. 5 pupils of the "House of Mercy" were provided with housing at the expense of the regional authorities. 2 people live in a student residence and 1 person lives in a rented house. The amount of the scholarship paid to 38 students with the 1st and 2nd disability groups and the 1st and 2nd groups of disabled people from the Student Encouragement Fund is 776,820 soums. Additionally, the amount of 1,364,2392 UZS is paid for the purpose of social support (for daily needs) to each of the 8 pupils of the "House of Mercy. In connection with the advent of the new year 2022, the Institute provided financial incentives to 42 students in need of social protection. 5 internal orders and 1 order to improve the social situation of students and ensure the fulfillment of the tasks set at the video conference "On setting priorities for ensuring the employment of students of higher educational institutions", held on March 4, 2022 under the leadership of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Sh.M. Mirziyoyev to provide employment for the population. At the university, 19 students in need of social protection are provided with additional employment in their free time, students are engaged in informal activities and are supervised. And also 13 low-income, truly orphans, disabled students of Yoshlar Daftri and

Temir Daftar were hired by the university as laboratory assistants, carpenters,

technical workers in an agricultural contract for 0.5 staff units. 5 students are employed as coaches at the Navoi City Sports Palace, 0.25 employees at Triumph Gornyak LLC.
