

## YOUTH POLICY OF THE UNIVERSITY

Youth policy is a priority area of state activity of the Republic of Uzbekistan in order to create socio-economic, legal, organizational conditions and guarantees for the social formation and development of young people, the disclosure of their creative potential in the interests of the whole society.

The state youth policy in the Republic of Uzbekistan is based on the following principles:

caring for young people regardless of national, racial, linguistic, religious affiliation, social status, gender, education and political beliefs:

legal and social protection of youth;

continuity of national, cultural traditions, spiritual connection of generations;

support for youth initiatives, guaranteeing the freedom of choice by young people of ways to realize their interests, carried out within the framework of the Constitution and laws of the Republic of Uzbekistan;

direct participation of young people in the formation and implementation of policies and programs for the development of society, especially the life of the youth of the republic;

unity of rights and duties, freedoms and civil liability.

Based on the law "On State Youth Policy". dated September 14, 2016 No. ZRU-406, a student representation was organized at the Navoi State Mining and Technological University, which is called the "Union of Youth of Uzbekistan" NGGTU. The student representation of the "Union of Youth of Uzbekistan" NSTU has its own governing Council at the university. The Chairman of the Council of Students of the "Union of Youth of Uzbekistan" NSTU is a member of the Council of the university itself.

The student representation of the "Union of Youth of Uzbekistan" NGSTU has certain rights in accordance with the provisions of the republican "Union of Youth of Uzbekistan":

Participate in the educational program of the university, make proposals and introduce active work on the effective activities of student employment in their free time from the main educational process, take an active part in the spiritual and educational activities of students of NSTU.

The youth policy of the university activates the creative activity of various public organizations,

which is expressed in holding competitions and reviews of student and student youth in all regions of the country.

The creative impulse of youth is manifested in the debates of pupils and students held at the university. It should be noted that an intellectual socio-cultural process is taking place at the university, that is, a massive surge in the educational and creative impulse of young people, which opens up unexplored expanses of the spiritual potential of the younger generation.

The ultimate goal of this process is the comprehensive preparation of young people for life, for independent development, who are able to resist various ideological influences and solve life problems.
